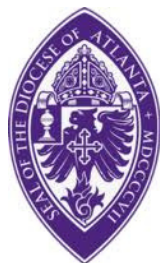

## PARISH UPDATE Church Office Addition May 13, 2026



Following a detailed review of five proposals from local General Contractors, a contract for the office addition was awarded on May 12, 2026 to Appalachian Design & Development (ADD), Inc. based upon their price, experience and close proximity to our campus.

ADD President Jeff Henke has decades of experience managing commercial construction projects that include churches and restaurants. His firm also built the ballroom addition to the Tate House.

All are invited to a Groundbreaking Ceremony on Sunday, May 24 following the single 9:30 AM service for Pentecost. The anticipated start date for construction is Monday, June 1, 2026. For everyone's safety, the construction site and adjoining areas will be fenced and off limits to everyone.

The group is reading and discussing the book, *Evelyn Underhill: Essential Writings* by Evelyn Underhill (Author) and Emily Griffin (Introduction). The book is available on Amazon. Evelyn Underhill (1875-1941), an Anglican writer and spiritual director, was the author of several classic works on mysticism. Increasingly regarded as an outstanding voice in twentieth-century spirituality, she was largely responsible for the modern rediscovery of mysticism. For Underhill mysticism was not simply an esoteric corner of Christianity, it was a normal expression of authentic spirituality with relevance for all people in everyday life. Questions?
