Our clergy and staff will never ask you, especially by email or text, to purchase gift cards, send cash, or share sensitive financial or personal information. If you receive a message that creates a sense of urgency or makes you feel like something "isn't right", **DO NOT REPLY OR CLICK ANY LINKS**. Email addresses (unless actually hacked) usually do not match the email address in your contacts. Phone numbers can be spoofed and appear to be coming from the actual phone number (and name) of your contact, so be extra cautious of any urgent texts on your phone that make you feel uneasy. When in doubt, please take a moment to verify by calling the person from your known contact list; do not reply to the email or text to make contact. A quick phone call can prevent a costly scam.
