## This week at Holy Family



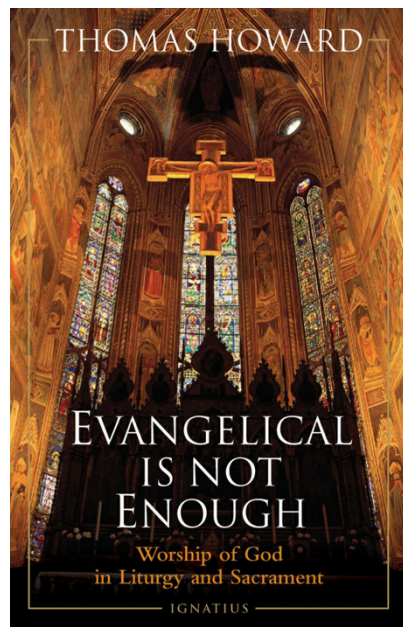

### SERVICE

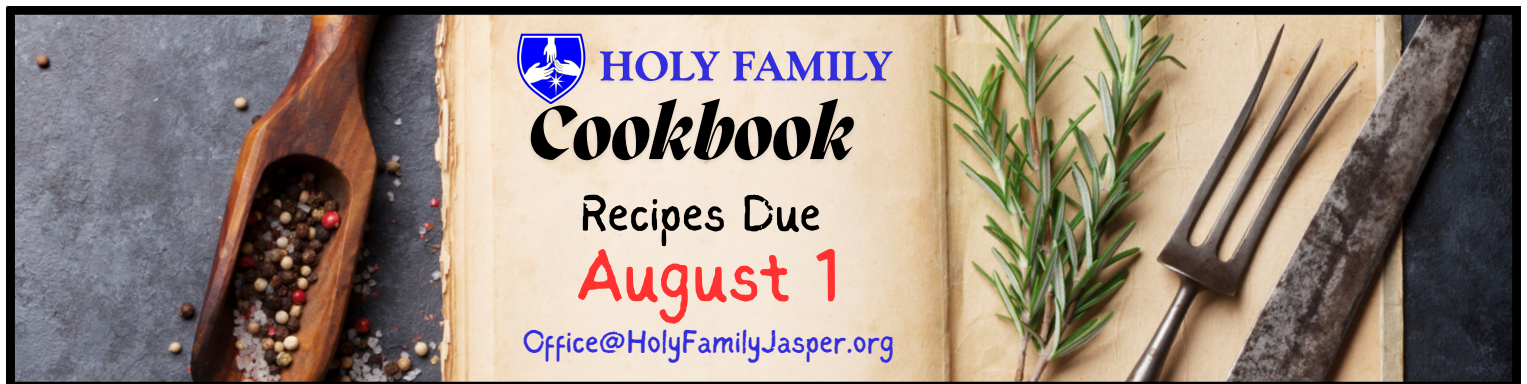

In about 1/2 mile on the left is the beach on the lake. Follow the unpaved road to the Pavilion.



**THURSDAY YOGA RETURNS TO HOLY FAMILY!** We're excited to welcome Cathy Harmon as Thursday yoga returns to the Conference Center beginning August 6 (no class August 20). A certified yoga teacher and yoga therapist, Cathy has been practicing yoga since 1985, when she discovered just how much tension her body was holding. "I knew I wasn't flexible, but was shocked to realize how much tension my body was holding. I found yoga to be rich and challenging, but so rewarding; I knew it was a practice I would continue throughout my life."

Cathy taught her first class on September 11, 2001, earned her 500-hour Yoga Teacher Certificate from Irene and Dr. Bill Beer of Namaste International in 2004, opened Grapevine Yoga in Texas in 2005, and became a full-time instructor. In 2009, she earned her 500-hour Yoga Therapist Certification and continued teaching group classes and private therapy sessions until 2016, helping people of all ages and abilities experience the benefits of yoga.
