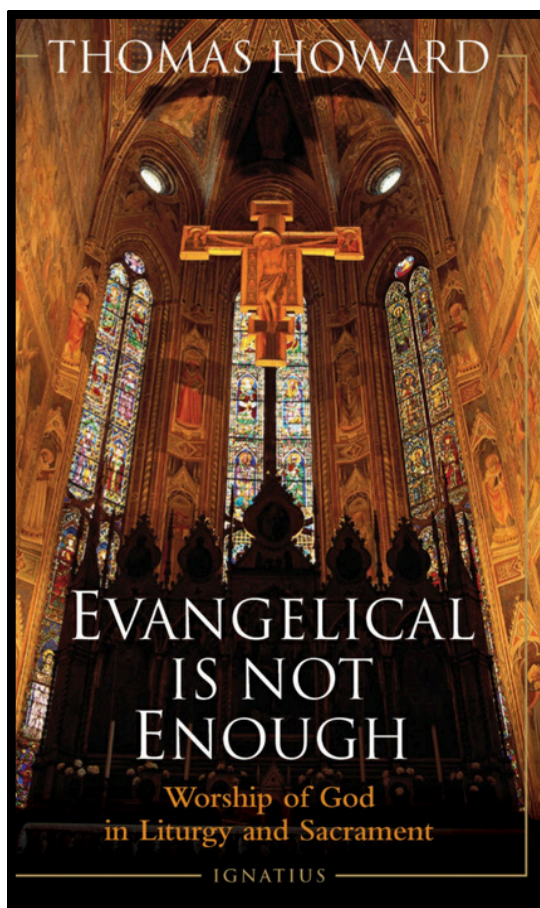
This week at Holy Family

2026-2027 SESSION STARTING SOON: SIGN UP NOW!

Education for Ministry (EfM) is sponsored by The School of Theology at the University of the South. At Holy Family, the deadline for registration is approaching, and we can still accommodate a few new participants for 2026-27. Sessions begin **August 31** and run for 36 weeks. The group is 6 to 12 participants, plus the mentors. We meet weekly for about 2.5 hours. *Many of our participants meet in person, but we also welcome participants who can only join by Zoom.* Additionally, Zoom is used when there is a threat of inclement weather.

Every baptized person is called to ministry. EfM provides people with the education "to be" Christians and to carry out their ministries. EfM is a worldwide program developed by the School of Theology at Sewanee. It holds that the foundation of bringing Christ to the world lies in a church empowered by active, theologically articulate laity. Thousands have completed the program. Participants enroll one year at a time, can transfer almost anywhere in the U.S.A. and many foreign countries, and can obtain 18 Continuing Education Units per year.

You don't have to be Episcopalian, or even Christian, to participate. If you are interested, just ask any current or former participant or Byron Tindall or Jeannine Krenson, the mentors. You can also check the Sewanee website. The cost is \$370 per year. THURSDAY YOGA RETURNS TO HOLY FAMILY! We're excited to welcome Cathy Harmon as Thursday yoga returns to the Conference Center beginning August 6 (no class August 20). A certified yoga teacher and yoga therapist, Cathy has been practicing yoga since 1985, when she discovered just how much tension her body was holding. "I knew I wasn't flexible, but was shocked to realize how much tension my body was holding. I found yoga to be rich and challenging, but so rewarding; I knew it was a practice I would continue throughout my life."

Cathy taught her first class on September 11, 2001, earned her 500-hour Yoga Teacher Certificate from Irene and Dr. Bill Beer of Namaste International in 2004, opened Grapevine Yoga in Texas in 2005, and became a full-time instructor. In 2009, she earned her 500-hour Yoga Therapist Certification and continued teaching group classes and private therapy sessions until 2016, helping people of all ages and abilities experience the benefits of yoga.
